

Concordance des textes de Nag Hammadi. Les Codices XIb, XII, XIII

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The seventh volume of the “Concordances” series of the Bibliothèque copte de Nag Hammadi includes the texts found in the second half of codex XI (*Allogenes* and *Hypsiphron*), codex XII (the *Sentences of Sextus*, the *Gospel of Truth* and the Fragments), and codex XIII (the *Trimorphic Protenoia* and the fragment of the *Writing without Title* on the origin of the world). These texts have been brought together in a single volume because of their dialectal similarities. The format of the volume, including the establishment of lemmas and the arrangement of occurrences, conforms to the model followed by the first, third, fifth and sixth volumes of the “Concordances” section. One finds here as well a “list of textual criticism” preceding the concordance proper, which will be extremely useful for those wishing to reconstruct the editorial history of the texts treated in this volume.

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
